The short term relief provided by the passage of Referendum C will end in 2010. Nonprofit, business, labor, education, cultural, social welfare, faith, and governmental leaders share a concern about what the future will hold for key public services and investments after it expires, but no consensus on a permanent fix has yet emerged. Any new resources or any reform to Colorado's rigid and conflicting constitutional policies on fiscal matters must be approved by the voters. These are complex matters that deserve our sustained attention and a commitment to developing public awareness in order to reach a permanent solution.
